### "If I didn't have to collect water, I could play with my friends."

Dear Lions Clubs,

These are the words of six-year-old Nancy, who lives with her family in the remote village of Tombohuaun, Sierra Leone. Together with her younger cousin Lucy, they're very much the village's own double act – singing, dancing and showing off, just like many of our own children and grandchildren will be doing this Christmas. Not a day goes by when Nancy and Lucy aren't by each other's side, but one thing threatens their special friendship. Dirty water.

My colleague Abigail recently returned from Tombohuaun, where she saw for herself that every day Nancy and Lucy have no choice but to drink water filled with dirt, parasites and disease. Three times a day Nancy heads off with her Mum, Fatu, to the edge of the village, where, at the foot of a muddy slope, is what Abigail describes as a puddle. It has a distinct brown colour, with flies and mosquitoes buzzing around it. I'm sure you are as appalled as I am to hear that this is Nancy and Lucy's only source of water.

It's water that has already taken lives, and stolen childhoods. But this Christmas, as one of our most valued supporters, I wanted to invite your club to be part of a unique opportunity to give Nancy and Lucy a brighter future.
