The Trustees thank PDG Brigid Hendy for her support and advice and for her contribution to the orderly functioning of the Trust.

Objectives

The objectives of the Trust are to hold the Trust Fund and its income upon trust to apply them for any purpose which is charitable according to the law of England & Wales whether for the benefit of any individual, or group of people, or for the benefit of any other organisation established for charitable purposes.

Statement of Public Benefit

The Trustees have complied with the duty in section 4 of The Charities Act 2006 to have due regard to public benefit guidance published by the Commission.

Main benefits result from the work of:
